

Evaluation

The data derived from subsequent observations verify that the Detensor-Therapy is sufficiently effective in the treatment of children with bronchial and gastroenterologic pathologies. The favorable effectiveness is due to the positive influences of the healing method upon the function of the central and vegetative nervous system. An evaluation of the effectiveness of traction treatment on genetically determined diseases of the nervous system and epilepsy is not yet possible due to the small number of observations. Apparently in these cases, a more concise choice for the selection of children for Detensor-Therapy must be undertaken. The conditions are to be primarily aimed at the improvement of the state of the central and vegetative nervous system by careful and comprehensive treatment.

Indications for the Detensor-Therapy are bronchial asthma, the chronic dermatorespiratory syndrome, gastroduodenitis, spasmodic seizures, pseudoallergic hives provoked by the background of vegetative circulatory dystonia with parasympathetic dominance.

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
